Jackie, our administrator, and Jon our chairman, are continuing working in various forms. Please pray that they remain safe in their work and that they can continue as key workers. Jon and Ruth are currently unwell with symptoms of COVID-19 and Rachel, one of our trustees, has already experienced a period of illness. Please pray for a swift recovery as well as God's protection.

Please pray for our friends in Uganda. Most of our recent contact with pastors has been regarding COVID-19, they are particularly concerned about us in the UK as they hear on social media and via the radio of the virus spreading. They also are in lockdown. There is a curfew which begins at 7pm and, whilst many are keeping to this, those who aren't face increased resistance from the Local Defence Units (LDUs) who are tasked with enforcing it. We have seen reports of Ugandans being shot and even killed if they break curfew and it is causing fear and panic in the community. Please pray for a swift resolution to this problem and for the safety of those we know and love in that country. Please also continue to pray for those in poorer areas where there isn't the money for hand sanitizer and the medical facilities are not equipped to cope. In Uganda, washing your hands in hot water isn't always an option.

Please pray for the courses currently running in Uganda; whilst restrictions mean that groups cannot gather, we understand that the courses run by both Patrick and Julius were in operation before the pandemic and therefore we ask that you pray for their swift continuation once the panic has settled. We also ask you to pray for the blessing that the course will be for those who are sitting it and remember in your prayers the congregations that it will benefit. *From Prayer Update*
