SCRIPTURE – *Matthew 5 : 38 - 48*
THEME – *Jesus the Revolutionary*

Prayer awareness : Tearfund

It can be difficult to know where to start when praying for a crisis as large as coronavirus. But as Tearfund Ambassador and founder of 24/7 Prayer, Pete Greig says: 'I am convinced that prayer is not only our greatest privilege but also our greatest source of power.' Our God is able to do immeasurably more than we can ever ask or imagine. Tearfund have created a prayer guide to help us bring everything before God at this incredibly difficult time using the acronym PRAY (praise, reflect, ask, yield). Here's how it can be used:-

Praise

Listen to, or sing, a song of worship to help you focus on God and become aware of his presence.

Reflect

To help build your faith, reflect on the nature of the One to whom we pray.

Ask

For many families in poorer countries, being in lockdown means no longer being able to earn enough to feed their children. As Tearfund delivers emergency food and supplies to the most vulnerable communities, ask for God's provision for these families in need.

Millions of people around the world, who may get very ill from coronavirus, have no access to any healthcare. Tearfund has created resources containing life-saving health advice and is sharing these with communities throughout the world. Ask God to protect countries where there is a lack of basic healthcare and pray that governments release funds to help these countries tackle coronavirus.

Yield

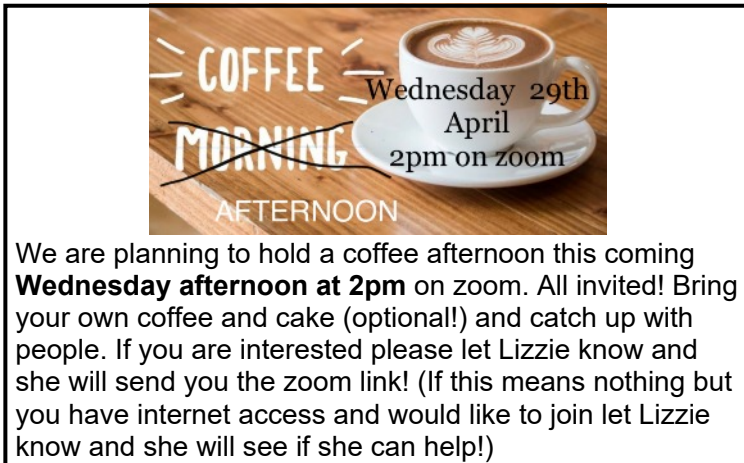
Lord, show me how you would have me show love to my local and global neighbours in this crisis, in both prayer and action.
