**Prayer awareness : Tearfund**

Millions of people living in poverty around the world were struggling to survive before the coronavirus pandemic began. Now, they are not only facing the risk of the virus, but the risk of hunger. Lockdowns have put people under unimaginable strain for months. For many who depend on a daily wage, losing work for just one day leaves them unable to put food on the table. With no savings or safety net to fall back on, starvation can be a bigger threat to some than coronavirus.

Since the beginning of the pandemic, Tearfund has been working with local partners in 36 countries to respond quickly to the urgent needs of the most vulnerable communities. So far, over 10,000 food packages have been distributed to those going hungry. As the crisis continues, teams on the ground are committed to providing ongoing support to those in need.

Please pray for those around the world who are struggling to meet their daily needs.
