As some of you will be aware, very little news has been coming out of Uganda since early January as the internet was turned off prior to the presidential elections. In some rural areas, the internet is only just beginning to work again and even then, it is sporadic. Some Ugandans, such as Samuel Muhumuza and Julius Bigirwenkya have only managed to briefly get in contact. However, we thank God that, despite the rioting and political tension that has occurred in the country over this tumultuous time, all our brothers and sisters in Uganda are well. Please join us in praying that the contact difficulties will ease, both between our Ugandans brothers and sisters, and between ourselves and those we know and love in the country.

We also pray for the continuing political tension between President Museveni and the opposition leader Bobi Wine, we pray that God will ease this tension and allow both sides to seek repentance and friendship from the other. In our brief communications with those in Uganda we have heard that there is a plan for pre-candidate classes (years 5, 9 and 11) to restart their education and join the candidate classes who have been back in education since before Christmas. We thank God that, for school children at least, a bit of normality is returning in Uganda. Please pray that those returning to school remain safe from Covid-19 and are able to catch up on their missed education.
