

Please pray for the continuing political tension in Uganda since President Museveni's winning the election and that God will ease this. There have been reports of widespread corruption and human rights abuses during the campaign.

We praise God that Uganda schools reopened on the 1st March to much joy and celebration. This has proved testing for some friends who run schools in Uganda. Schools have had to become 'Covid secure' in order to open and this has meant a list of purchases. For many of our contacts this is an unrealistic expense costing nearly £1000 per school. Please pray that their government will provide some support and that all schools will open. We have heard from several contacts that children, particularly girls, are at risk if they are not in school. In some areas the number of girls who have been sexually assaulted is 40%. We pray with our Ugandan friends that they will be able to open soon and care for these vulnerable children.

In other news, Stella, the wife of one of our sponsored pastors, Steven Biso, has had hospital treatment for a large growth. Please pray for Stella and that the operation has eased her symptoms. Martin Sebbugo just informed us that the first Covid vaccine has been made available in Uganda and we pray that the rollout goes well. We also join in celebration with Simon Muwezera and his church in Masese as, after a long period of fundraising and hard work, they have finally moved into their new (brick-built) church building. We thank God for his blessings on Simon and the community that he serves and pray that He continues to pour His blessings out.
