Praise and Worship

Message Study Notes for 9th May 2021

Revelation 5 verses 6 to 14

The subject of worshipping God is throughout the bible. All creation offers God praise and worship (e.g. Psalm 19, Psalm 98, Romans 8, Isaiah, Revelation)

Read Isaiah 55 verse 12. What does this say to you about worship?

The bible says that all earthy things, when they function properly, give God glory.

Read Ephesians 1 verse 12, then Revelation 5 verses 6 to 14. If worship of God is our purpose, how does that scene make you feel?

Spiritually, God offers to lead us into new levels of understanding his desire for intimacy with us; then worship ceases to be boring. Instead, it becomes an opportunity to express something deeply meaningful.

Can worship be boring? In what way? Why?

Worship is an attitude of honour and adoration that is expressed through service, celebration and praise. **How can we praise God through serving others?**You cannot praise God silently in the corner at home or at the back of the church with

If that is true, how can we praise God relevantly, first at home, then in church?

When you sing and praise, that's worship. When you pay attention to what's being taught, and don't try to sleep, that's worship. When you greet other people and show unity and harmony, that honours God and is worship. When you participate in house group, that can be praise and worship.
