When Papua New Guinea's government said that all aircraft passengers must carry a negative COVID-19 test before they can fly, nurse Marieke Noordhoek, wife of MAF pilot Corné, volunteered to run the coronavirus testing facility on behalf of MAF. Video link: <https://youtu.be/a98Ql4nqJJY>

'When the passengers arrive,' Marieke explains, 'I write down their names and their occupation on the form, as well as the reason for they're being tested. 'After that, we conduct a test, which is a swab going into the nose, apply the buffer liquid to the test strip and wait 15 minutes to get the results.'

The atmosphere around the testing area is tense as people await their result nervously. Once a negative result has been confirmed, a noticeable sense of relief and happiness takes over!

'Most of our passengers are teachers returning to school,' says Marieke, 'so they are very important in making sure there is good education for communities in remote places.'

The tests are of great importance to MAF, as we continue doing everything we can to protect isolated communities and minimise the possibility of spreading the virus.

- That Marieke is protected from coronavirus as she goes about testing MAF's passengers. Thank the Lord for her servant-hearted ministry.
