



MAF News for Prayer

When MAF pilots Arjan Paas and Markus Bischoff arrived in Maramuni, Papua New Guinea (PNG), with goods for the villagers, they unloaded their cargo and got ready to depart. However, as they were about to close the doors, a man ran towards the plane, talking animatedly to one of MAF's personnel. It turned out that a man in a nearby village had fallen from a tree and was so badly wounded that he couldn't walk. His friends originally planned to carry and then drive the man to a local hospital, but when

they heard the sound of MAF's aircraft landing at Maramuni, they had a better idea. Arjan explains what happened next:

'The man at the airstrip asked if we could wait for about ten minutes. We said of course we would, and a little while later a group of men appeared, carrying a makeshift stretcher with the wounded man.' If the messenger had arrived five minutes later, MAF's plane would have left the airstrip. But this, according to Arjan, 'was [God's] perfect timing'.

According to the pilot, our aircraft 'delivered the man and his brother to Mount Hagen where he could receive the care he needed.'

Please pray

- That the man who fell from the tree will be able to walk properly again, and be aware of how God enabled his timely hospital trip to take place.
- For safety for our team, serving sacrificially in PNG. A number of the airstrips there are particularly challenging.
- For MAF medevacs taking place throughout the developing world. Without our medical emergency flights, countless lives would be lost and ill and injured people left untended.
